Supplies for Science and Social Studies:

- College-ruled 3-hole notebook paper
- Red pens for correcting, blue or black pens, pencils
- 3 x 5 inch spiral bound memo pad (Kawasaki's class only)

Supplies for Language Arts:

- 3 x 5 inch index cards
- One 1½ inch binder
- One package of dividers (minimum 7 dividers)
- Blue or black pens
- Red pens for correcting
- Pencils and erasers
